Pool Rules (as posted on pool gate)

- 1. There should be no solo swimming.
- 2. There should be no running boisterous or rough play.
- 3. No person under the influence of alcohol or drugs should use the pool.
- 4. There should be no spitting or blowing nose in pool.
- 5. Persons with diarrheal illness or nausea should not enter the pool.
- 6. Persons with skin, eye, ear of respiratory infections should not enter the pool.
- 7. Persons with open lesions or wounds should not enter the pool.
- 8. No animals or pets allowed in the pool area.
- 9. No glass allowed in the pool or deck.
- 10. No children under the age of 14 should be in the pool without supervision.
- 11. You should take a shower before entering the pool.
- 12. This pool is open from 6am, to 11pm.
- 13. The maximum number of swimmers allowed in the pool is 80.
- 14. A first aid kit is located on the club house deck wall.
- 15. Life saving equipment is located at fence next to pump house.
- 16. An emergency phone (or other notification device) is located on club house deck wall.
- 17. The pool manager of record at this facility is Pat Provost Certification Number 848.

Safety Information

Swim at your own risk; there are no lifeguards. Diving is not permitted, including running racing dives.

If there are any safety issues, gate locks not working, broken glass, etc please call numbers listed on the sign in the pool.

Pool fobs

Lost fobs are \$10.00 for replacements, exterior bathroom key replacement cost is \$3.00. If you don't have a fob, please don't wait till the day before opening to contact Pool Chair for one. It can take up to 24 hours to register and activate a new fob. Fobs are issued to a person/family and are for their use, and that of their guests, only.

Anyone not current with their assessments will not receive a fob, or will have their current fob deactivated until dues are paid.

Other Information

If you bring a float to the pool, be courteous of the other users; and if it's very crowded please don't use your floating raft or lounger.

Although the pool area itself cannot be reserved, you can use it for small parties or gatherings, with the proviso that it is not your private area and tables and chairs are for the community use. Please make sure all trash is removed from the pool area.

Every year at the end of pool season there are unclaimed items, including clothing, that usually end up being trashed. Please try to take home all your property when you visit the pool.
