

# Schieveling Garbage/Trash/Recycling Pickup

## Normal Schedule

<p>Biweekly Up to June 6 2022 - Wednesday 7:00am June 6 2022 and after - Friday 7:00am</p>	<p><a href="#">Blue Recycling</a> bin. Follow this <a href="#">County Map and Schedule</a> county link for the schedule (includes current and future schedule). <p>Thursday 7:00 am</p>	<p><a href="#">Green Garbage</a> bin, plastic bags of household waste. Small items not in the bin will <b>NOT</b> be picked up. Yard Waste (e.g., paper bags of leaves, branches). Plastic bags will <b>NOT</b> be picked up. Follow this <a href="#">Charleston-sc.gov</a> link for details (use the map to see your collection day). For more information call 843-720-3882.</p>
<p>Thursday 7:00 am</p>	<p>Yard Waste :</p> <p>“All leaves, twigs, weeds and grass clippings shall be placed in brown paper bags designed for the purpose of leaf and clippings disposal. It is the responsibility of the resident to provide the necessary bags.</p> <p>Tree limbs and stumps need to be cut into 4-foot lengths and 4-inch diameter and stacked curbside clear of obstructions.</p> <p>Miscellaneous materials, which may include personal construction materials, wood or metal scrap.</p> <p>No household garbage may be placed with yard waste for pick-up.”</p>
<p>Friday 7:00 am</p>	<p>Bulk pickup follow <a href="#">Charleston-sc.gov</a> link for details. <b>“Some pick-up services will need to be scheduled ahead of time via the <a href="#">Citizen Services Desk</a> (843-724-7311). There may be additional fees.”</b></p>

## Guidelines

- During the holiday week, your collection generally occurs one day later than your regular day. You may check the City’s Website ([www.charleston-sc.gov](http://www.charleston-sc.gov)) or visit the City’s Facebook Page ([www.facebook.com/CityCharleston](http://www.facebook.com/CityCharleston)) for the exact dates your garbage or trash will be picked-up.
- “Unacceptable waste for single-family residential collection includes hazardous waste (examples include: paint, auto fluids, batteries, and household and pool chemicals), concrete, dirt, sod, sand, plaster, carpet, construction and renovation debris, tires and hot ashes.” Use Bee's Ferry Landfill for items not allowed for residential pickup.
- Bins and waste can be placed at the curb the day before scheduled pickup no earlier than 6:00 pm.
- Bins must be removed and out of sight by the end of day of the pickup.
